TRAPP project aims to facilitate, secure and promote long-term mobility for apprentices in Europe by exchanging good practices and creating new tools to improve them.

As a result of the current health situation, the French Erasmus + agency has agreed to **extend the project implementation to February 2022.**

The pilot phase of the project's cross-mobilities has been postponed to autumn 2021 and will now take place between September and November 2021.
