### OUR PROJECT

The Erasmus+ project *TRAPP - Training for Apprentices* is a joint project of four partner countries. France, Italy, Finland and Germany are working hand in hand on the implementation. The project, which has a duration of 24 months, is financed by European Union funds. The kick-off meeting took place in Lyon in October 2019.

### OUR MOTIVATION

We want to contribute to the European citizenship and promote mobility in training. Very few trainees are currently going abroad for two month or longer. Most mobilities are significantly shorter stays. However, too few trainees still have the chance to gain experience abroad during vocational training.

### OUR GOAL

We want to enable long-term mobility for apprentices.  
We are developing a strategy so that SMEs can carry this long-term mobility without losses.  
We have vocational colleges on board to ensure compliance with the curriculum and certification.



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# Focal points

The project partners have agreed on four main areas of work, the so-called intellectual outputs, in order to be able to implement the common goal of a successful long-term mobility:

- 1.IO: Legal framework: Which laws and regulations have to be followed?
- 2.IO: Human Resources: How can the workforce in the companies be maintained?
- 3.IO: Pedagogical framework: How can compliance with the curriculum be guaranteed?
- 4.IO: Evaluation & certification: How can we use ECVET and Europass for evaluation and certification?

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## Pilot phase

In the pilot phase, all four partner countries send and receive one apprentice from the hairdressing trade and one from the automotive mechatronic trade. The apprentices receive a financial grant from *TRAPP - Training for Apprentices* for their two-month internship abroad. The posting times are expected to be in the first quarter of 2021 and the country constellations are as follows:

Germany <> Italy: hair dresser  
Italy <> Finland: car mechatronic  
Finland <> France: hair dresser  
France <> Germany: car mechatronic
